We currently offer personalized e-mail names, graphical access accounts, webmail, 1-800 access, a range of account levels, website hosting, spam filtering, mail forwarding and others services expected by today's connected community.

What does the future hold?

With the ever-changing face of technology, members and future members may be sure that Chebucto's dedicated tech team will keep up with growing trends. Faster servers, more modems and an increased presence in our community are just three things to watch for in the coming years.

What was the internet like 10 years ago?

- Members used Chebucto as a way to receive e-mail and read newsgroups.
- Pizza Hut becomes one of the first e-commerce sites offering online pizza ordering to its customers.
- The first cyberstation, RT-FM, appeared on the net, broadcasting from Las Vegas.
- Yahoo! was founded by two Stanford PhD students
- Arizona law firm, Canter & Siegel, sent out the first spam with an email advertising their green card lottery services
- The first banner ads appear. They were for Zima, a clear beer-like drink, and AT&T.
